USPS Version 4.2 Release
Notes
Release Date: 2008.09**

This document contains information about changes, enhancements and problems corrected with the 2008.09 release of USPS Version 4.2.

1 Functional Enhancements and Changes

1.1 AUDRPT: Add new EMIS fields to audit report

When modifying USPSCN/DEMSCN, an audit for the master teacher and master teacher year have been added. The fields are called Master teacher code and Master teacher year, respectively.

When modifying USPSCN/JOBSCN, an audit for the EMIS Special Education FTE has been added. The field on AUDRPT is called EMIS Spec Ed. FTE.

1.2 NEWCNT/BUILD: Add EMIS Special Ed. FTE to new contract

Allow EMIS Special Ed. FTE field from USPSCN/JOBSCN to be moved to NEWCNT/MAINT screen.

1.3 NEWCNT/IMPORT: Add EMIS Special Ed. FTE to import of new contracts

Add <EMIS_SPEC_ED_FTE> for new EMIS field called EMIS Special Ed. FTE. Valid values are 0.00 through 9.99. This field is optional. If this field is not in the CSV file and adding a new record, the the values from USPSCN/JOBSCN will be used.

1.4 NEWCNT/MAINT: Add EMIS Special Ed. FTE to screen

Add EMIS Special Ed. FTE to screen 2. Valid values are 0.00 through 9.99.

1.5 NEWCNT/PURGE: Update JOBSCN with EMIS Special Ed. FTE

Whether performing a mass purge or an individual purge in new contract, the value in NEWCNT/MAINT for the EMIS Special Ed. FTE field will be carried over to USPSCN/JOBSCN. Also, the old JOBSCN value for the EMIS Special Ed. FTE will be saved and written to the Job History file (USPJOBHIS.IDX).

1.6 NEWCNT/REPORT: Add EMIS Special Ed. FTE to new contract report

Add EMIS Special Ed. FTE to report. This field can be found under the Salary Schedule information.

1.7 **QRTRPT: When running Demand report, change wording from closing quarter to reporting quarter**

When running the Demand Report option in QRTRPT, users were confused because it was asking for the closing quarter. This change was made on the June 2008 release so that a count of employees paid during the 12th of the last month could be calculated.

In an effort to be less confusing, QRTRPT has been modified. When the Demand Report option is selected, the user will be notified that when choosing the quarter, it is for informational purposes only. Also, when using the Demand Report option it will refer to it as the quarterly reporting period, not the quarterly closing period, as it was previously.

1.8 **QRTRPT: Include total employees paid in quarter count**

Added the count for the total employees paid in the quarter back into QRTRPT. This count will include any employee that has been paid in the current quarter. This is the count that was in QRTRPT before the June 2008 release.

For the June 2008 release, QRTRPT was modified to remove the total employees paid in quarter to only include employees in the count if they were paid on the 12th of the last month of the quarter. This change was made to be in compliance with the 941 instructions. However, if a district's payroll lag causes the pay that covers this period to not be paid until the next quarter, the count will be zero on QRTRPT.

Therefore, QRTRPT will now show both counts. The count that includes only employees paid on the 12th of the last month of the quarter will appear as Total employee count per 941 instructions. The count that includes employees paid in the quarter will appear as Total employees paid in quarter.

1.9 **SALARY: Add EMIS Special Ed. FTE to program**

Add logic to move USPSCN/JOBSCN value of EMIS Special Ed. FTE in Salary program to NEWCNT/MAINT.

1.10 **STRSMRG: New program to merge STRS annual submission file with Renhill files**

The STRSMRG program assists with the merging of the file created by STRSAD and the file provided by Renhill for those districts that utilize this service. This is necessary because STRS will only accept one submission file per district.

1.11 **USPCHG: Remove position status D, N, R and O**

Eliminate all logic relating to position status of D, N, R and O. These position statuses will now all be position status C. This also means that USPCHG options 5, 7 and 8 needed to be eliminated. Option 5 was to modify position status from 'New to district' (position status of N) to 'Active/continuing'. Option 7 was to modify position status from 'New position in dist' (position status of D) to 'Active/continuing'. Option 8 was to modify position status from 'Retire/Rehired' (position status of O) to 'Active/continuing'.

The option to modify the EMIS report flag to 'No' for jobs marked as 'No longer Employed' will now be option 5 in USPCHG.

The option to EXIT the program is now option 6.

1.12 **USPEMS/PERDET: Remove degree type and semester hours validation**

Remove the validation in PERDET where it produces the error that the semester hours are not high enough for the degree type specified. This validation no longer appears in the EMIS aggregations. The validation that has been removed is (if the degree type is 2 and the semester hours are not greater than 109) or (if the degree type is 3 and the semester hours are not greater than 134) or (if the degree type is 4 or 5 and the semester hours are not greater than 160).

1.13 **USPEMS/PERDET: Add new EMIS fields for validation and report**

Add validations for EMIS Master Teacher, EMIS Master Teacher Year and EMIS Special Ed. FTE according to ODE validation rules. Errors will show up on the report as an "!" next to the field in error.

1.14 **USPEMS/PERDET: Remove position status D, N, R and O**

Eliminate all logic relating to position status of D, N, R and O. These position statuses will now all be position status C.

1.15 **USPEMS/PERDET: Remove assignment areas 2 and 3**

Assignment areas 2 and 3 have been eliminated. They will no longer appear on PERDET report. Only assignment area 1 is being used by EMIS. Also, in validating of assignment areas only look at assignment area 1, not 2 and 3.

1.16 **USPEMS/USPEMX: Add new EMIS fields to extract**

Added EMIS Master Teacher, EMIS Master Teacher Year and EMIS Special Ed. FTE to EMIS extract.

Also, changed logic to always move assignment area 1 to assignment area.

1.17 USPIMPORT/ATTEND: Allow importing of retirement hours to UPDCAL

Allow a new field, retirement hours, to be included in the csv import file for ATDSCN. This field will be processed for AT (Attendance) entries that are posting to UPDCAL_CUR or UPDCAL_FUT. If a retirement hours value is specified in the csv file, then the value from the csv file will be the default for the UPDCAL entry. This is also true if the csv field value is 0. A zero value will force UPDCAL retirement hours to be 0. If the retirement hours value is NOT specified, the value in JOBSCN (retire hours or hours/day) will be used. The retirement hours is the last field on the csv file and is defined as alpha-numeric.

1.18 USPLOAD/BIOSCN: Add EMIS Master Teacher and Master Teacher Year to USPLOAD

Added the new fields for EMIS Master Teacher and EMIS Master Teacher Year that appear on DEMSCN to be loaded. The EMIS Master Teacher field is called "MASTER_TEACHER_STATUS" and the EMIS Master Teacher Year field is called "MASTER_TEACHER_YEAR".

1.19 USPLOAD/BIOSCN: Added new ECE qualification field for loading

The BIOSCN option of USPLOAD will now allow loading the ECE qualification field by using the ECE_QUALIFICATION field header. The old field header name for this field was DEGREE_TYPE. This field header was left intact and will still correctly load the ECE qualification field, however all new loads should reference the ECE_QUALIFICATION field name. Any existing loads should also be updated to use the new field name as DEGREE_TYPE is considered deprecated and will be eliminated with a future release.

1.20 USPLOAD/JOBSCN: Add EMIS Special Ed. FTE to USPLOAD

Added the new field for EMIS Special Ed. FTE that appears on JOBSCN, screen 2. The EMIS Special Ed. FTE field is called "EMIS_SPEC_ED_FTE".

1.21 USPLOAD/PAYSCN: Allow object codes greater than 199

Object codes greater than 199 were receiving warning messages when trying to run USPLOAD for PAYSCN records. This has been modified. Object codes are no longer being limited to the 100 range.

1.22 USPRPT/EMPMST: Add EMIS Master Teacher and Master Teacher Year to report

Two new fields have been added to the EMPMST report. The Master Teacher Status and Master Teacher Designation Year can be found in the BIOGRAPHICAL Section of the report.

1.23 USPSPRT/JOBHIS: Add EMIS Special Ed. FTE to report

Added EMIS Special Ed FTE to report. This field can be found with all the other EMIS fields.

1.24 USPSCN/DEMSCN: Add EMIS Master Teacher and Master Teacher Year to screen

Added the Master Teacher and Master Teacher Year to DEMSCN. These fields are called "Mstr Teach" and "Mstr Yr." and can be found under the birth date. These two fields are validated against ODE specifications. Valid values for the Master Teacher are "FA", "BC", or "NO". If "NO" is entered, then the master teacher year should be zeroes, otherwise the year will be ignored.

1.25 USPSCN/JOBSCN: Add EMIS Special Ed. FTE to screen

Added the EMIS Special Ed FTE field to second screen of JOBSCN, to the left of the Salary Schedule FTE. The field is called "Spec. Ed FTE" and is validated against ODE specifications. The EMIS Special Ed FTE can be 0.00-9.99.

Also, ODE is only allowing 1 assignment area per job. So, the second and third assignment areas have been eliminated from JOBSCN.

1.26 USPSCN/POSSCN: Eliminate second and third assignment area

ODE is only allowing 1 assignment area per job. So, the second and third assignment areas have been eliminated from POSSCN.

1.27 USPSCN/POSSCN: Add EMIS Special Ed. FTE to screen

Add EMIS Special Ed. FTE to first screen of POSSCN under the Position Information.

2 Problems Corrected

2.1 ATTENDXML: Not properly translating AD RH entries

The SOAP service was not updated to account for the new AD RH attendance type. The RPC service has been modified to account for this type starting with version four of the SOAP service. Any version previous to four will cause these records to be excluded from the returned recordset for the sake of backwards compatibility.

2.2 **JOBXML: Remove date range validations**

The following change applies to the USPS web application and any third party applications that use the USPS SOAP service.

The 'Position Start Date' and 'Separation Date' will no longer be validated to ensure that they fall within a specific date range. Both fields will now be checked to ensure only that they are dates. These fields were validated against the EMIS options file to ensure they fell within the range specified. However, this caused problems as the options file is never likely to be available at the beginning of the fiscal year.

2.3 **JOBXML: Position code validation corrected**

This update corrects the position code validation for the USPS web application. Previous to this change any numeric value would pass validation. Now the position code entered must be valid per the EMIS options file.

2.4 **NEWCNT/PURGE: Calculate retirement hours for LPE when purging a contract**

Currently when a new contract is purged and an LPE pay type in UPDCAL_FUT is created, there are no retirement hours associated with it. This has been fixed. The retirement hours will be calculated using the days remaining on the old contract and the retire hours/hours per day on USPSCN/JOBSCN.

2.5 **SALARY/BUILD NEW CONTRACTS: Retirement hours not getting moved to new contracts**

When a user is running the Salary program and trying to build new contracts (based on USPSCN/JOBSCN values) the retirement hours are not being moved to new contracts. This was resulting in blank retirement hours in new contract. This has been fixed to move the JOBSCN retirement hours value to NEWCNT.

2.6 **UDMS: Retire hours field not showing value after decimal point**

The value in retirement hours was only bringing in a whole number when using UDMS. This caused a problem when using Safari to update the retirement hours. The record layouts that were incorrect include JOB_POS_REC and USPNEWEMP_REC. The views that were incorrect include JOBS, JOB_POSITION and NEW_CONTRACTS. This has been corrected to bring in the entire retirement hour value including the number(s) after the decimal point.

2.7 USPLOAD/BIOSCN: ECE qualification field was not being validated correctly

The ECE qualification was not being correctly validated. This has been corrected and this field will now be validated against the EMIS options file. This change also corrects the web application's validation of this field.

2.8 USPLOAD/JOBSCN: Position code validation corrected

The position code to be loaded will now be properly validated. Previous to this update any numeric value would pass the position code validation. The position code will now be compared to the valid values as specified in the EMIS options file.

2.9 USPSCN/ATDSCN: Mass add not calculating retirement hours correctly

When entering an ATDSCN entry using the Mass Add feature, the retirement hours are not looking at the number of days/hours entered in ATDSCN. This has been fixed. The number of days/hours from ATDSCN are now correctly being figured into the calculation for retirement hours.

2.10 USPSCN/JOBSCN: Position code was not being validated

JOBSCN has been modified so the position code is correctly validated. Previously it was allowing any numeric code to be entered.

2.11 USPRPT/EMPMST: Correct evaluation for multilingual field

The multilingual field on EMPMST has been changed to evaluate value of "N" as "NO" a value of "Y" as "YES". Previously, it was evaluating for "0" and "1", respectively. This change is in accordance with the EMIS options file validation.

2.12 USPRPT/EMPMST: Correct evaluation for handicap status field

The handicap status field on EMPMST has been changed to evaluate a value of "N" as "NO" a value of "Y" as "YES". Previously, it was evaluating for "0" and "1", respectively. This change is in accordance with the EMIS options file validation.

3 Technical Enhancements and Changes

3.1 **DTR: Add new EMIS fields for FY08 to Datatrive file definitions**

Add EMIS_SPEC_ED_FTE to JOB_POSITION_REC.DTR_REC, JOB_HISTORY_REC.DTR_REC, and ALL_POSITIONS to USPS_VIEWS.DTR. Add MASTER_TEACHER_STATUS & MASTER_TEACHER_YEAR to EMPLOYEE_REC.DTR_REC and ALL_JOB, ALL_POSITIONS & EMP_WITH_JOB_LIST to USPS_VIEWS.DTR.

3.2 **DTR: Add retire hours to Datatrive file definitions**

Add RETIRE_HOURS to ALL_JOBS and EMP_WITH_JOB_LIST to USPS_VIEWS.DTR.

3.3 **GENERAL: Add new EMIS fields to USPEMP**

Add USPEMP-MSTR-TEACH and USPEMP-MSTR-TEACH-YEAR to USPEMP.GFD and USPEMP.LIB. This will be using the filler at the end of the file.

3.4 **GENERAL: Add new EMIS fields to USPJOB**

Add USPJOB-EMIS-SPED-FTE to USPJOB.GFD and USPJOB.LIB. This will be using the filler at the end of the file.

3.5 **GENERAL: Add new EMIS field to USPJOBHIS**

Add USPJOBHIS-EMIS-SPED-FTE to USPJOBHIS.GFD and USPJOBHIS.LIB. This will be using the filler at the end of the file.

3.6 **GENERAL: Add new EMIS fields to USPNEWEMP**

Add USPNEWEMP-EMIS-SPED-FTE to USPNEWEMP.FD and USPNEWEMP.LIB. This will be using the filler at the end of the file.

3.7 **ODJFSRPT: Program aborting when USPDAYS is called**

ODJFSRPT was receiving an improperly handled condition. This was caused by the counting of SERS hours in USPDAYS. This has been fixed.

3.9 UDMS: Added new ECE_QUALIFICATION field to appropriate records and views

The EMPLOYEES_REC and EMPLOYEES_REC1 records plus the following views: EMPLOYEES, BIOGRAPHICAL have been updated to include the ECE_QUALIFICATION field. This field was previously reflected in UDMS under the name DEGREE_TYPE. We have left the DEGREE_TYPE field intact so as not to break any custom views previously created. However, the DEGREE_TYPE field is considered deprecated and will be eliminated in a future release. All new views and any existing views that contain DEGREE_TYPE should be updated to use the ECE_QUALIFICATION field instead.

3.10 UDMS: Add new EMIS fields to UDMS dictionary record layouts

Add MASTER_TEACHER_STATUS and MASTER_TEACHER_YEAR to EMPLOYEES_REC. Add EMIS_SPEC_ED_FTE to JOB_POS_REC. Add EMIS_SPEC_ED_FTE to USPNEWEMP_REC. Add EMIS_SPEC_ED_FTE to USPJOBHIS_REC.

3.11 UDMS: Add new EMIS fields to UDMS dictionary views

Add MASTER_TEACHER_STATUS and MASTER_TEACHER_YEAR to the BIOGRAPHICAL and DEMOGRAPHICAL views. Also, added EMIS_SPEC_ED_FTE to JOBS, POSITION, JOB_POSITION, JOB_HISTORY & NEW_CONTRACTS views.

3.12 **USPS0809: Initialize new EMIS fields for October 2008**

Created a program called USPS0809 to initialize the new EMIS fields for the USPEMP, USPJOB, USPNEWEMP and USPJOBHIS files. These fields are using filler space at the end of the file.

The program will initialize USPEMP-MSTR-TEACH to "NO" and USPEMP-MSTR-TEACH-YEAR to zeroes in USPEMP.IDX.

The program will initialize USPJOB-EMIS-SPED-FTE to zeroes in USPJOB.IDX.

The program will initialize USPNEWEMP-EMIS-SPED-FTE to zeroes in UPSNEWEMP.IDX.

The program will initialize USPJOBHIS-EMIS-SPED-FTE to zeroes in USPJOBHIS.IDX.

This program must be ran on all the districts files. There is a command procedure called USPS0809.COM that may be used to submit this initialization program for batch processing.

3.13 **USPSFY09CONV: Conversion program that attempts to intelligently convert position codes, assignment areas, and position statuses to new values per FY09 EMIS requirements**

This program will convert existing position codes, assignment areas, and position statuses based on the FY09 EMIS requirements. A report named FY09CONV.TXT will be created in the districts OECN\$DTA directory listing any errors and/or mapping issues that occurred. There is also a USPSFY09CONV.COM procedure included in this release that facilitates executing this program in batch.

5 **Documentation**

The documentation is maintained by the SSDT and can be found in the OECN\$ROOT:[USPS.V4P2.DIST] distribution directory.

5.1 **Documentation Summary**

The following are documentation files for the Uniform Staff Payroll System package and a brief description of the contents and intended audience of the document.

Documentation produced for this package was developed with a Digital product called VAX Document. This product enables us to provide two versions of the documentation for various types of printers. The version which has an extension of .LN03 can be printed on a laser printer; while version with the extension of .PS is to be printed on a ScriptPrinter.

5.2 Documentation _UPDATE Files

The users have the ability to print the updates to the documentation manuals since the previous release, without having to print the entire documentation manuals. The updates are contained in a separate file which uses the same naming convention as the normal manual with "_UPDATE" appended. The update files are available in .LN03 and .PS versions. You will find updates to both the user and system manager manuals if changes have taken place.

The update files will include **ONLY** the modified chapters of the documentation manual, a new table of contents, and an index if one exists in the documentation manual. Updated documentation is also included in the normal documentation manuals. Therefore, if you plan to print the newest version of the entire user or system manager manual, it will **NOT** be necessary to print the update file.

It should be noted that even though the purpose of the update files is to allow the users to print only the updates, there may be cases when it would be more practical to print the entire documentation manual, rather than trying to use the update file. For instance, if a new chapter is added at the very beginning of the manual, the numbering for all subsequent chapters will change as well (the size of the update file could be almost as large as the normal documentation manual). SSDT will advise you in the release notes when the changes are so numerous that we recommend that you print the entire documentation manual.

There will only be one _UPDATE file provided each release for every manual. We do not plan to distribute updates for previous releases, as we do for the release notes.

SSDT strongly advises that you print new documentation manuals before you try to utilize the _UPDATE files.

If you print a .PS version of the entire documentation manual, be sure to print the .PS version of the _UPDATE files. The _UPDATE pages will not fit into the manual properly if you try to mix the various documentation formats.

If there are no changes in the documentation manuals, no _UPDATE file will exist on the release.

6 Package Installation and Logicals

Installing USPS involves first using the OECN_INSTALL procedure to unpack the savesets into the OECN\$ROOT:[USPS.V4P2.DIST]. After the distribution directories have been prepared, INSTALL_PACKAGE is used to transfer the package from the distribution directory into the user execution directory. See the VAXMGR_HANDBOOK in OECN\$ROOT:[DOCUMENT.DIST] for more information about OECN_INSTALL and INSTALL_PACKAGE.

Prior to executing INSTALL_PACKAGE it is necessary to define several system logicals required by the package. The table below lists the logicals which should be defined prior to executing INSTALL_PACKAGE for USPS:

Table 2 System Logicals

Logical	Description
OECN\$PAY_42	Shared directory. Contains executables and files shared by all USPS
OECN\$CDD_PAY_42	CDD path name (optional, see next section)
OECN\$MENU\$FILES ¹	Location for menu files
OECN\$HELP ¹	Location of VMS help libraries

¹Also used by other packages

Note: USPS also requires components from the OECN and CSSR packages. These packages should be installed prior to installation of this package.

6.1 Installing CDD/DTR Definitions

The USPS distribution contains optional CDD and DTR definitions that are acceptable for use with DTR, 20/20 and other products that are integrated with DEC CDD/Repository. Data names for COBOL are provided in the record definitions. The CDD definitions are optional and are not necessary to successfully install and utilize the base USPS package. However, there are a few "supported" DTR reports. If you wish to be able to use these reports, you must install the CDD definitions.

The INSTALL_PACKAGE procedure OECN\$UTL will load the CDD definitions into the CDD when either the "CDD" or "FULL" option is used to install USPS. INSTALL_PACKAGE is the only supported method for installation of CDD definitions for USPS Version 4.2

The USPS CDD definitions for USPS Version 4.2 will be loaded into the CDD path referenced by the OECN\$CDD_PAY_42 logical. This logical must be defined prior to executing INSTALL_PACKAGE and should be defined as a system logical. SSdT recommends that the USPS definitions be placed in a separate CDD directory from other CDD definitions. This increases the efficiency of the CDD, allows the USPS definitions to be

treated as a 'database' from 20/20, and simplifies security maintenance.
For example:

```
$ DEFINE/SYSTEM OECN$CDD_PAY_42 CDD$TOP.OECN.USPS42
```

After defining the OECN\$CDD_PAY logical, the INSTALL_PACKAGE may be executed. Below is sample run of the CDD installation:

7 UDMS Dictionary Implementation

USPS contains a dictionary for use with the UDMS Report Writer product. The dictionary will be installed automatically when OECN\$UTL:INSTALL_PACKAGE is executed with either the FULL or UDMS option. If a version of the dictionary has already been installed, INSTALL_PACKAGE will merge the updated version into the local copy. Thus, reports and additional views developed locally will be preserved.

USPS also contains a sharable image which is used by UDMS. The sharable image provides 3GL functions which are used in calculated fields by the UDMS dictionary. To make this image available to UDMS, you must define the following logical during system startup:

8 Implementation of this Release

Please implement this release as soon as possible. It is difficult for the SSDT to provide assistance to your problems if you are not utilizing the current version of the software supplied.
